Dear Neighbors:

During our July meeting our guest speaker, Principal DeMarko Wright of Garfield Elementary School, spoke about the importance of teaching children to respect their community. Principal Wright described a program called Promise Keepers that partners residents with the PTA. The YMCA and Carle have been asked to participate with in a health day as well. The focus is to develop community pride and rebuild the neighborhoods in which we live. Principal Wright will provide more information as it becomes available.

A subcommittee was formed to develop ideas for a neighborhood block party. This subcommittee will bring their suggestions and details to the August meeting. Many questions about the toters and rules have come up. A hand out of the municipal code chapter 93 was distributed during the July meeting. This hopefully has answered those questions such as when to place them and when to bring them in. The most frequent question asked is this:

*§ 93.11 PLACING GARBAGE FOR COLLECTION (D) No garbage receptacle shall be placed for collection as described herein prior to 5:30 p.m. of the day preceding the scheduled collection day for the premises. No garbage receptacle placed for collection as described herein may be left at the place for collection after midnight on the scheduled collection day for the premises.*
