Dear Residents of Center City,

On April 18th we held the first activity day of Season 3. Thank you to everyone who helped out. We had a successful street/alley trash collection, from Gilbert to Vermilion, and a tree trimming. Not only is our neighborhood more clean and inviting because of our efforts, it was also a great opportunity for conversation and socializing. Another work day will be scheduled this season. In between these whole neighborhood clean ups, we'll need to keep our own curbs clear. We can request the PrideGrows trailer from the City for any project. If you have a project, such as taking out a tree, in mind at your home let us know. It wouldn't be any trouble to schedule an activity day.

It's also important to clean up after our pets. There are times when dogs are walked and do business in other people's lawns. Please clean up you dog's mess as a courtesy to your neighbors. No one likes having to clean up after someone else's animals.

There have been reports of one or more people stalking our alleys and watching houses. A few weeks ago a home was broken into to. Each of us is responsible for the safety of the place we live. I encourage you to report any suspicious activity to 911 right away. I know each of us in this neighborhood will do our part.

The Public Works Department is working on a sewer project in the 1300 block of Walnut, Franklin, and Oak. During this construction traffic on Voorhees St will be disrupted. Yard waste collection has begun. Yard waste may be placed in brown paper lawn bags or trash cans/toters with a 2009 collection sticker. Stickers are available for \$10, for the entire season, at City Hall. The collection stickers are certainly lower cost than purchasing bags.

The next meeting, May 7, we'll be discussing ideas for a neighborhood party. All ideas are welcome as we plan for this event. The neighborhood action plan is also progressing. When the remaining questionnaires are turned in, the next workshop will be scheduled for the end of June. This workshop's purpose is for creating our vision statement and the goals and objectives to meet that vision.
